## **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

- 1. Maintenance Staff are assigned a master key to access your apartment for service requests. You do not need to leave your door unlocked if you have authorized us to enter while you are not at home!
- 2. No cooking is allowed on balconies or patios in accordance with the Town and City of Geneva codes. No propane tanks are allowed on the property (only charcoal grills used twenty (20) feet from the building), which must be put away when done and the ashes must be cool and properly disposed of so as not to start a fire.
- 3. Working on cars is NOT allowed in the parking lots.
- 4. If you have visitors, make sure they park in overflow/guest parking areas so residents may park in front of their building.
- 5. No pools are allowed on the property.
- 6. Pets are not allowed without prior, written permission from the property office. We currently have a no pet policy.
- 7. Do not flush ANYTHING down toilets except toilet paper.
- 8. Do NOT dispose of grease down any of the drains and rice, noodles and pasta may not go in garbage disposals.
- 9. Dumpsters are for household trash ONLY. If you have items such as furniture, tires, electronics, etc. to dispose of, please contact the property office for assistance.

At the Holiday Manor property:
Do NOT use back fire exits to access the backyards. These are NOT meant for daily use.

They are for emergency use ONLY!

### BUG OUT!!!!

In general, residents themselves can provide the best defense against ants and pests in their apartment. There is a very common myth that if you seal all the cracks and holes over every square foot of your apartment that you will stop bugs from getting in. In reality, we are on their turf and they will find a way in, no matter how many cracks or holes you seal. Of course, that doesn't mean there aren't things you can do, as a resident, to reduce the prevalence of bugs in your apartment.

There is really one main tip and that is: **Don't give bugs a reason to come inside.** They're not in there for shelter or companionship, they are there for FOOD! Take away the food source and you take away the bug. Here are 5 specific tips to help prevent bugs from making your home their home.

- 1. Keep your **doors leading outside closed** as much as possible.
- 2. **Sweep and vacuum** frequently. Bugs love crumbs.
- 3. Keep the **counters and surfaces clean and free of food**.
- Seal food properly that you leave in the cabinets or pantry.
- 5. Keep the **trash area clean and remove the trash** often.
- 6. Do not store grocery bags underneath sinks.
- 7. Rinse pop bottles and remove them regularly.
- 8. Do NOT bring furniture or any items left in/by the dumpsters (use furniture could be harboring bed bugs!).
